Admission to research studies with a licentiate as the final degree

The undersigned hereby agrees to have been admitted to research studies with a licentiate as the final degree.

This means

- a programme comprising 120 credits, which corresponds to two years of full time study (or four years of part time study)
- no guarantee that the studies will continue and lead to a doctoral (PhD) degree
- in order to continue with third cycle studies towards a PhD degree, a new application for admission must be submitted to the postgraduate education committee
- if admission is granted, the licentiate degree will be equated with a midway review and the remaining research studies will be carried out within the framework of an appointment to a doctoral studentship (applies to full time doctoral students).
